Autumn Leaves

Burgundy Rose
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Leaves

Trace leaf pattern onto single layer of muslin. Cut as many or as few as you like. Don't worry if they are not perfect! In nature no 2 leaves are exactly the same! :) To paint them, I like to soak them in water first, and then wring them out so they are just a little damp.

Lay them all out onto a cookie sheet and grab your paints! I based my leaves in Dark Goldenrod first. While your leaves are still wet, paint random strokes all over you leaves with Forest Green, Pigskin, Burgundy Rose, and Brown Iron Oxide. Don't be afraid to overlap your leaves! This will add character! Let your leaves dry. Peel you leaves off your cookie sheet. (My cookie sheet is covered in paint so literally have to peel them off! LOL!) If they are not dark enough for you, then repeat the painting process.

Grubby it up!

OK! We are almost done!! Lay your leaves back on the cookie sheet and spray with a mixture of instant coffee and hot water. (Mix 3 parts water to 1 part instant coffee.) While they are still wet, sprinkle with cinnamon! Now rub it in really good! Let it dry. Don't flatten them! You want them to look dried and crinkly! ;)

You're all done! Scatter your leaves around your favorite Autumn project! :)

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
