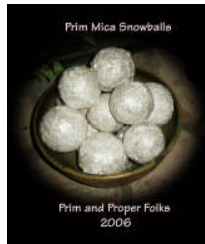


## Free Prim Holiday Snowball Recipe



Oh my gosh...aren't these the most adorable snowballs? I think these prim snowballs are so much fun to decorate with over the winter months and holidays. You can use them as bowl fillers or with your dolls or even attach a string and hang them on your tree!

Here's what you will need:

Styrofoam balls (whichever size you prefer)  
Joint compound (drywall mud)  
Wax paper or aluminum foil  
Gloves - this is very important for this messy project  
Mica or glitter  
Fragrance (optional)

Holding your styrofoam ball, scoop up some joint compound in your gloved hand and cover the ball completely. Set on wax paper or aluminum foil and let dry. I like to use two coats so once the compound is 90% dry I add a second coat.

If you would like to cover the snowballs in mica or glitter, just roll the snowball in it while the compound is still wet and set aside to dry.

If you like them grungy, you can add a little burnt umber acrylic paint to the compound before applying, or spray the snowballs with walnut stain or coffee mixture and then set aside to dry.

If you like your snowballs scented, I like to add my favorite scents right to the compound before applying. Enjoy!
