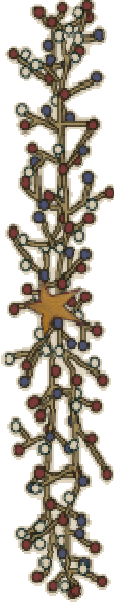

X's & O's (Hugs & Kisses)

MATERIALS NEEDED:

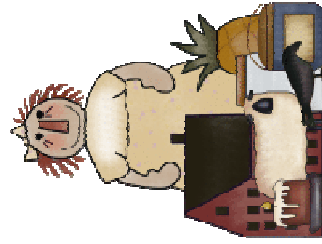
8 pieces of different fabrics
(or fabric of your choice)

Fiberfill

Needle and Thread

Instant coffee & Cinnamon

Basic sewing supplies

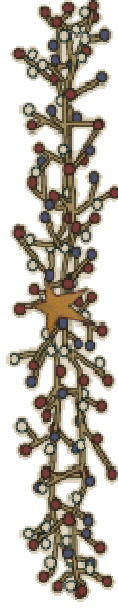

X's & O's

For coffee stain I mix 4 or 5 tablespoons of instant coffee with about 1 cup of HOT water. If you want it darker add more coffee or if you want it lighter add less.

You can also use modge podge and apply glass glitter or mica flakes. You can also use the O to make some fabric donuts! They'd be so cute using a contrasting fabric for "frosting" and use beads for sprinkles! Try out different fabrics!

These X's and O's make great bowl fillers and ornaments...make them bigger for pillows or smaller to add to fixins! Make up a bunch and put them in a mason jar and give as a gift! I'd love to see how you use them if you make them!

X

Trace around the entire X on the **WRONG** side of doubled fabric. Sew on the line. Cut a small slit thru one layer of fabric in the middle of the x and turn right side out. Stuff firmly and whipstitch opening closed.

Whipstitch

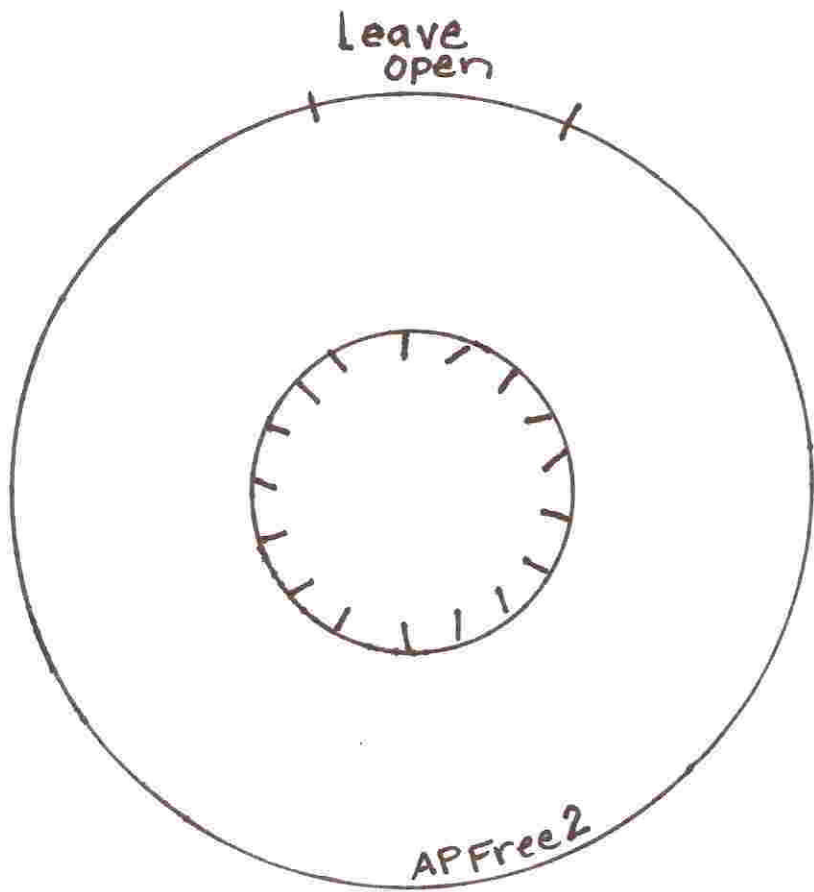
Use a whipping motion over the raw edges to finish.



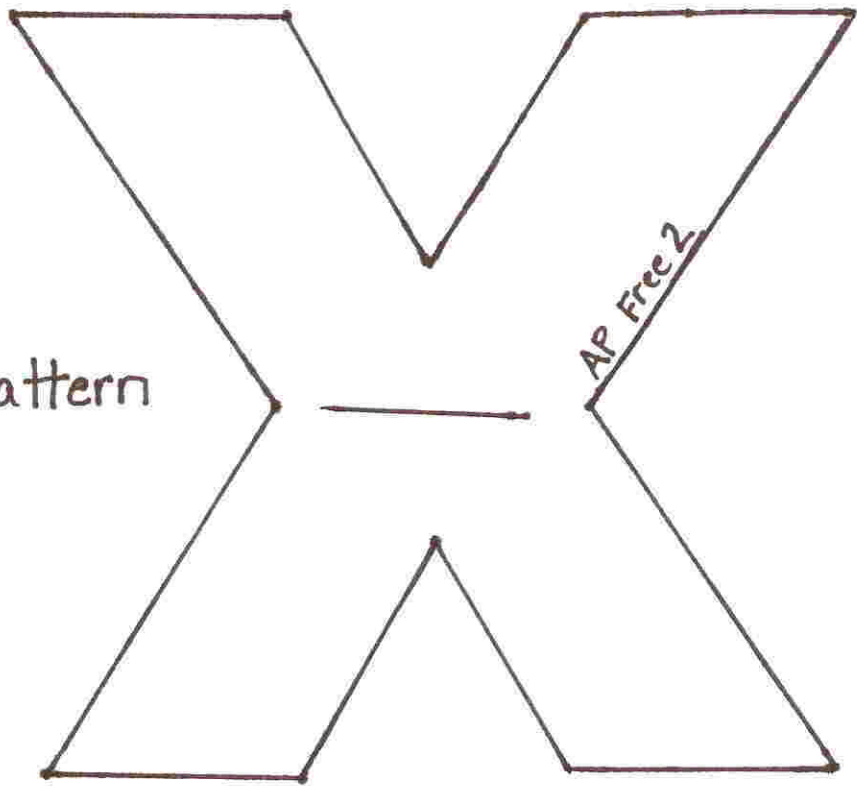
O

Trace pattern onto wrong side of doubled fabric. Sew around **OUTER** circle leaving a 1" opening. **DO NOT SEW INNER CIRCLE!** Fold the fabric so that you are able to cut the center circle 1/4" away from drawn line (to the outside of the line) Clip notches around inner circle about every 1/4". Turn O right side out. This next part is a tad tricky. Turn under the edges of the small circle and whipstitch closed to form the hole in the O. Tuck just a little at a time and take your time doing it. You'll need to make very small whipstitches to keep the stuffing from poking out! Stuff firmly and whipstitch the 1" opening closed.

I used a sponge brush to brush the coffee stain on and then while they were wet rubbed them with cinnamon. I let them dry overnight but since they were still wet in the morning I put them in the oven on the lowest setting for about 30 minutes. (KEEP AN EYE ON THEM!)
