*RSO: Right side out

*RST: Right sides together

Palette- Delta Ceramcoat

Terra Cotta

Ivory

Seminole Green

Prismacolor Artist Pencils (for eyes)

White

Special Supplies

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard Muslin

Stick or dowel for stems

Coffee and cinnamon for staining

Off white button thread

Black embroidery thread

Fiberfil

Punpkin

Cut 6 pattern pieces from muslin for each punkin. Sew each piece together, one at a time making sure to leave ends open where indicated on pattern. Sew a running stitch around one end with button thread. (This will be the top of the pumpkin) Do NOT pull tight yet! Place a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " stick in top, keeping $\frac{1}{2}$ " sticking out. NOW pull your stitch tight, wrap the thread around the stem a few times then knot to secure. Turn RSO. Stuff firmly! Sew another running stitch around the bottom and pull shut.

Paint punpkins Terra Cotta. Let dry!

Face

Transfer eyes and nose patterns on punkins. Stitch eyes and nose with 3 strands of black embroidery thread.

Highlight sides and bottom of eyes and nose with White pencil.

Trace 1 mouth pattern onto single layer of muslin. I like to paint my mouth BEFORE I cut them out. Make it easier to paint! :) So transfer the details of your mouth to your fabric. Paint mouth Ivory and let dry. Outline and shade mouth and teeth with Dark Umber pencil. Now cut them out leaving about 1/8" allowance (see Pattern). Stitch the mouth to the punpkins with button thread. Highlight cheeks with White pencil.

Leaves

Pattern lines are cutting lines for the leaves! Cut out as many or as few as you like! Paint leaves Seminole Green. Let dry. To attach the leaves, I actually take the stem out and place the leaf in the hole then replace the stem. You can add a touch of tacky glue to secure the stem if desired, or you can stitch or glue leaves to tops of punkins.

Grubby it up!

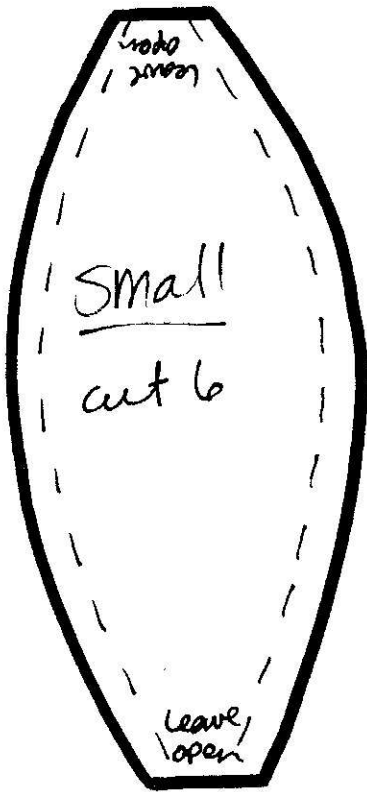
If desired, mix 3 parts water to 1 part instant coffee. Place into a spray bottle and spray your entire project. If you want them really grubby then, while they are still wet, sprinkle with cinnamon! Now rub it in really good! Let it dry.

You're all done! You cute little punkins are ready for display! :)

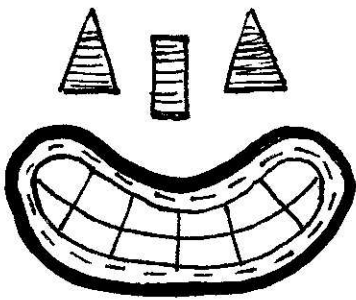
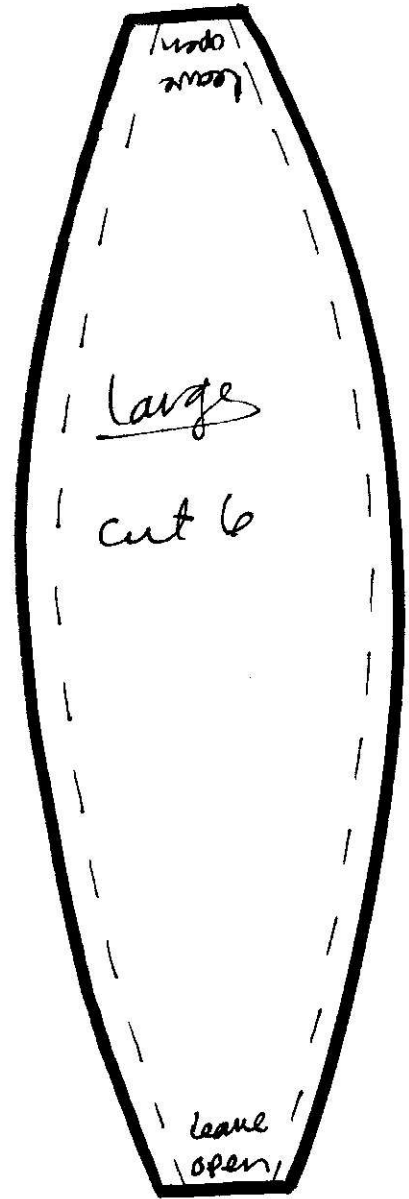
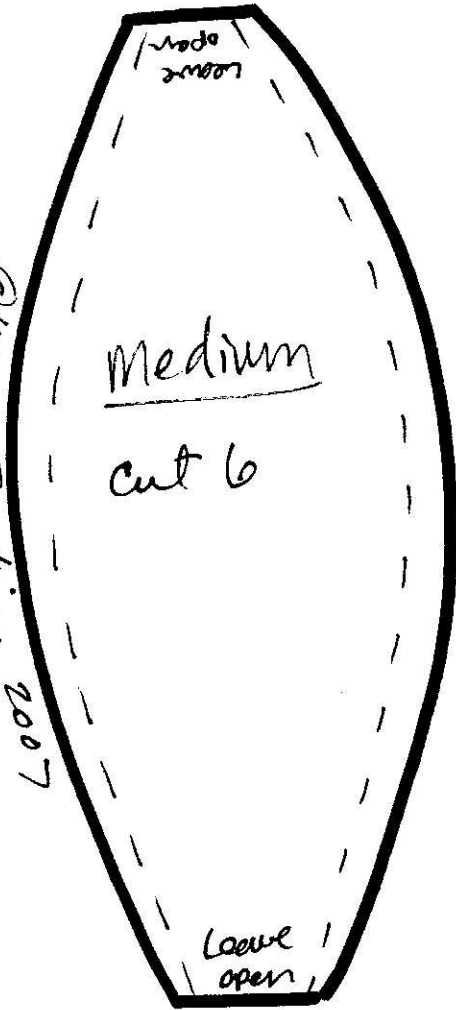
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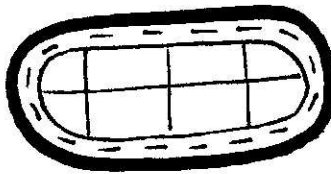

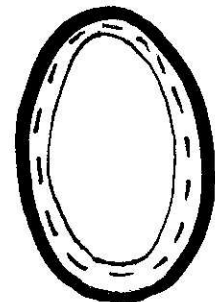
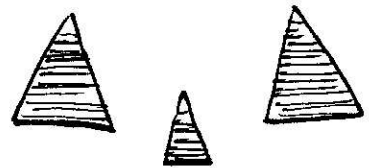
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Small face
